 - Report on Admission (see attached report)
 - The Search Process how we go about finding students
 - Inquiry conversion first step is inquiry interested in TCU, campus tour, met in High School; joined mailing list through website – hot leads; higher inquiry score, the higher they'll apply and be admitted
 - Core group of zip codes
 - Score high schools and how the students from them perform in our funnel – impacts us how we'll market and travel
 - Personality of TCU supportive environment, lots of school spirit,
 - Use conditional logic in marketing for personalized letters; Gen Z want boutique message
 - TCU Recent Past
 - Students are going to larger public schools; smaller/regional schools are struggling in many cases
 - Lower enrollment for lower income students; the higher the income the higher the likelihood a student is to enroll
 - TCU puts a lot of money on the table for our lower income Texas residents
 - Culture war idea that college isn't worth it
 - Headwinds
 - Recent Supreme Court ruling erased race conscious admission
 - Chatgpt
 - The Student Search Cliff decline in enrollment due to birth rates
 - TCU is very popular, so we need to preserve space for those who apply later
 - Retention rate is 94% we're attracting higher quality students and the work of everyone on campus staying connected with students (first to second year)
 - graduation rate is 85.5%
